Festival d'art actuel - Les Humanoïdes

PUBLIC ART PROJECT

Deadline: Wednesday, May 5th, 2021

The Edmundston Arts Center is looking for proposals from artists, groups and arts organizations, to participate in a public art project that will take place in Edmundston this fall.

Artists are invited to install temporary or permanent contemporary artworks, in public spaces, including works from the **visual arts** (painting, sculpture, performance, installation, etc.), the **literary arts** (poetry, essays, etc.), **sound arts, including experimental music** (performance, installation, etc.), as well as **cultural mediation activities** (workshop, discussion with the artist, etc.).

TERMS OF SUBMISSION

Location:	Edmundston, especially outside and/or downtown
Timeframe:	September to November 2021
Honorarium:	According to CARFAC rates, conditional on budget approval
Eligibility:	Professional and/or emerging artists and/or new artistic practices
Priority:	Candidates from and/or living in the Edmundston region or New Brunswick and/or engaged in a professionalization process and/or recognized by their peers.

Proposal Content

The proposal must include:

1. Contact details (name, phone number, email, postal address)
2. Detailed description of the project (one page maximum)
3. Artistic statement (one page maximum)
4. Artistic Resume
5. Artistic biography
6. Media clippings (optional)
7. Digital images and/or videos of artworks in JPG format (maximum of ten)
8. Detailed list of images/videos (title, year, medium and dimensions)

Evaluation Criteria

- Artistic merit – 50 %
- Meets priorities – 30 %
- Professionalism of the proposal – 10 %
- Ability to complete the project – 10 %

Selection Process

1. Proposals will be evaluated by the Centre des arts, represented by the curator, with expert advice and/or input from the arts community and/or partners, as needed.
2. The Centre reserves the right to invite a potential candidate to submit a proposal after the closing deadline, in the case that received proposals are insufficient in number, deemed ineligible or non-priority and/or with a preliminary assessment under the 70 % mark.
3. The Centre reserves the right to make the final decision in order to ensure a balance between different artistic styles, techniques and philosophies, and for a fair representation of official languages, genders, cultural communities and the strategic objectives of the Centre.
4. Only selected candidates will be contacted.
